## RE: PRODUCED WATER AND NON-HARZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL SPECIAL PROJECT CANCELLATION SECURE DAWSON CREEK A11-4-79-14 (WA# 24497) DAWSON CREEK FIELD – BLUESKY FORMATION

The subject well was drilled and completed in the Baldonnel formation in November of 2008. The Baldonnel zone was abandoned, and the Bluesky was then completed. The Bluesky remained unused until disposal operations began in July of 2009, following its approval for disposal, granted in March of 2009. Disposal operations ceased in November of 2014, with a total cumulative disposal volume of 185 e<sup>3</sup>m<sup>3</sup>. On March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022, Secure Energy Services Inc. indicated to the Commission via email communication that they have no plans for future disposal and had no concerns with cancellation of the disposal approval.

Pursuant to the *Oil and Gas Activities Act (OGAA)* section 75(2)(b), the Commission may cancel, suspend or amend a designation (iii) if the Commission considers that the designation is spent, or (iv) if the Commission considers that the designation is no longer appropriate, including, without limitation, for reasons of (a) public safety, (b) protection of the environment, or (c) conservation of petroleum and natural gas resources.

The Special Project Approval 09-02-001 for the Dawson Creek field, Bluesky formation well Secure Dawson Creek A11-4-79-14 (WA 24497) is hereby cancelled under section 75(2)(b) of OGAA. In accordance with Section 75(2)(b)(iii), the Commission considers that the designation is spent.
