IN THE MATTER of a pressure maintenance scheme of Suncor Inc. Resources Group (Suncor) for waterflood recovery of oil by water injection into the Blueberry Debolt "B" Pool.

The Minister of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources, pursuant to section 116 of the Petroleum and Natural Gas Act, hereby orders as follows:

1. The pressure maintenance scheme of Suncor for waterflood recovery of oil in the Blueberry Debolt "B" Pool as such scheme is described in the Application from the Operator to the Ministry dated October 18, 1993, is hereby approved subject to the terms herein contained.
2. The pressure maintenance scheme area shall be delineated by unit 70, Block K; units 61, 71, 72, 81, 82, 92, 93, Block L, 94-A-12; units 2-4, 13, 14, 24, 25, 34-36, 45, 46, 56, and 57, Block D, 94-A-13.
3. Water may be injected into the Blueberry Debolt "B" Pool through well d-93-L/94-A-12.
4. The scheme shall be deemed to have commenced upon water being injected into the well referred to in clause 3, with the Ministry being notified in writing of the date of commencement.
5. Progress reports shall be filed as stipulated in Part 9, section 108 of the British Columbia Drilling and Production Regulation.
