
**RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLING OF OIL PRODUCTION
BURNER DEENA ET AL W EAGLE 16-3-85-19 W6M; (WA 8863)**

This acknowledges receipt of your application dated December 17, 1994, requesting permission to commingle oil production from the Montney "B" and Belloy "A" pools in the subject well of the Eagle West field.

Your request for commingling is justified in this case as Montney "B" pool is considered to be very small. Also, it is noted that Home Oil Company Limited, operator of the Eagle West Unit No. 1, indicates that they have no objection to Burner's proposal to commingle Montney and Belloy oil production. Therefore, we wish to advise that your application is hereby approved subject to the following conditions:

1. Production from the Montney "B" (1869-1871 mKB) and Belloy "A" (1896-1908 mKB) pools may be commingled.
2. The daily oil allowable (DOA) for the combined pools is 32.1 m³.
3. Gas, oil and water production should be allocated to the pools on the BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Montney "B" 20% and Belloy "A" 80%.
4. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change of circumstances.
