
**RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION

CADOTTE "A" AND BASAL BLUESKY "D" POOLS**

This acknowledges receipt of your application dated November 26, 1991, requesting permission to commingle production from the Cadotte and Basal Bluesky pools in the subject well.

We wish to advise that your application is hereby approved (under Part 4, Division 5, section 44(1) of the British Columbia Drilling and Production Regulation) subject to the following conditions:

1. Production from the Cadotte perforations at 2102.5-2113 mKB and the Basal Bluesky perforations at 2567.5-2573.5 mKB may be commingled.
2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated to the formations on the BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Cadotte "A" 95% and Basal Bluesky "D" 5%.
3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change of circumstances.
