RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION CANHUNTER NOEL a-67-1/93-P-2; (WA 6637) CADOTTE "M" AND FALHER A "D" POOLS

This acknowledges receipt of your application dated November 26, 1991, requesting permission to commingle production from the Cadotte and Falher A pools in the subject well.

We wish to advise that your application is hereby approved (under Part 4, Division 5, section 44(1) of the British Columbia Drilling and Production Regulation) subject to the following conditions:

- Production from the Cadotte perforations at 2162-2173 mKB and the Falher A perforations at 2294-2300 mKB may be commingled.
- 2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated to the formations on the BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Cadotte "M" 70% and Falher A "D" 30%.
- 3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change of circumstances.
