CADOTTE "N" AND BASAL BLUESKY "G" POOLS

This acknowledges receipt of your application dated March 17, 1992, requesting permission to commingle production from the Cadotte and Basal Bluesky pools in the subject well.

We wish to advise that your application is hereby approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Production from the Cadotte perforations at 1938-1948 mKB and the Basal Bluesky perforations at 2412-2423 mKB may be commingled.
- 2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated to the formations on the BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Cadotte "N" 70% and Basal Bluesky "G" 30%.
- 3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change of circumstances.
