Approval is granted to co-mingle gas produced from the Bluesky and Dunlevy R

- The term of the approval will expire on June 1, 1975.
- II. During the term of the approval gas production will be allocated to the producing formations on the basis of monthly production tests as suggested in your application. Results of these tests should be filed with this office and should include 24-hour production rate information (gas and liquid), wellhead temperature and wellhead pressure data.
- III. Segregation will be maintained between the produced fluids in the wellbore. Co-mingling will only occur in the surface facilities.

This co-mingling approval is to enable your evaluation of the Dumlevy formations producing characteristics. After June 1, 1975 either segregated metering equipment must be installed or one zone must be suspended.
