RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION MORRISON BEATTON B-76-J/94-H-2; W.A. 8810

This acknowledges receipt of your application dated January 4, 1995, requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Charlie Lake 'A' and Charlie Lake 'V' markers in the subject well.

It should be noted that the ministry designates the Charlie Lake A' as the A Marker "A" pool and the Charlie Lake V' as the Coplin "A" pool. We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production from these two pools is hereby approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Production from the Coplin "A" pool (1123.75-1125 mKB) and A Marker "A" pool (1133.5-1135 mKB) may be commingled.
- 2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated on the BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Coplin "A" 40% and A Marker "A" 60%.
- 3. The approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate though a change in circumstances.
