RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION NUMAC MARTIN a-48-G/94-H-6; WA# 9259

The Ministry has reviewed your application dated January 10, 1997, requesting permission to commingle gas production from the Bluesky, Gething, and Baldonnel formations encountered in the subject well.

The Petroleum Geology Branch recognizes that in this well the Gething and Baldonnel formations are in direct contact in the reservoir and have created a single pool code, the Gething-Baldonnel 'A'. Thus all production from the completed interval of 1088.5 - 1115.0 mKB may be produced without a commingling approval.

Gas potential in the Bluesky member has not yet been proven in this well, but would appear to be minimal. Should this zone be completed and tested separately, a request should be made to review the conditions of this approval.

We wish to advise you that your application to commingle production is hereby approved, under the authority of section 44 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Production from the Bluesky and Gething-Baldonnel (1088.5 1115.0 mKB) formations may be commingled.
- 2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated on the BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms on the basis of Gething-Baldonnel 100%.
- 3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
