RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLED PRODUCTION REMINGTON ET AL RIGEL C-12-C/94-A-15 (WA 9192)

This acknowledges receipt of your application dated April 5, 1995, requesting permission to commingle production from the two perforated intervals in the subject well.

Based on the ministry's geological interpretation, the perforated interval 1022-1025 mKB is designated as Rigel Bluesky "D" pool whereas the perforated interval 1039-1043 mKB is designated as Rigel Dunlevy "F" pool.

We wish to advise that your application for commingling these pools is hereby approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Production from the Bluesky "D" and Dunlevy "F" pools may be commingled.
- 2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated to the Dunlevy "F" on the BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms.
- 3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change of circumstances.
