RE: APPLICATION FOR COMMINGLING OF GAS FORMATIONS SCEPTRE ET AL N GRIZZLY c-B63-G/93-I-15; WA# 8748

This acknowledges receipt of your application dated January 16, 1994, requesting permission to allow commingling of the Cadomin and Dunlevy formations via the open hole section of the subject well.

Verbal approval was granted on January 12, 1995, for the placement of a bridge plug above these two zones, without proper abandonment, in order to allow for their possible future exploitation.

We wish to advise that your application is hereby approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Any future production from the Cadomin and Dunlevy formations may be commingled.
- 2. Gas, condensate and water production should be allocated to the Dunlevy on the BC S-1 and BC S-2 forms.
- 3. This approval may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
