## **APPROVAL 97-07-001**

## THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS ACT MINISTRY OF EMPLOYMENT AND INVESTMENT ENERGY AND MINERALS DIVISION

IN THE MATTER of a Concurrent Production proposal of Blue Range Resource Corporation (BRRC) for producing the Silver Halfway "D" Pool with a project oil and gas allowable.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Division Head, pursuant to section 113 of the *Petroleum and Natural Gas Act* (the Act), hereby approves the Concurrent Production project of BRRC for oil and gas production with project allowables, as such project is described in

an Application from BRRC to the Division dated November 29, 1996, and related submission.

This project is approved, subject to the conditions herein contained and, in particular:

- 1. The area of the project shall consist of Units 38, 39, 48, and 49 of Block K/94-H-6.
- 2. The project oil allowable is 15.0 m<sup>3</sup>/d.
- 3. Gas production from the project will be limited to 15.0 10<sup>3</sup>m<sup>3</sup>/d.
- 4. All associated gas production must be conserved.
- 5. Royalty-exempt oil production from the discovery well Blue Range Silver d-48-K/94-H-6 (WA# 8918) is limited to a volume of 3,002.1 m³ or the volume produced in the first 36 producing months, whichever is lesser. This volume cap may be subject to review and amendment following additional production data.
- 6. This approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate.
