N½ Section 15-85-14W6, Boundary Lake Halfway

This refers to your application dated 1985 02 25 requesting approval to concurrently produce oil and gas under Good Engineering Practice from the Boundary Lake Halfway pools underlying the N½ Section 15-85-14W6. Notice of your application was published in two consecutive issues of the British Columbia Gazette.

As no written objections were received by 1985 04 25, your application is approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The area of concurrent production and Good Engineering Practice is $N^{\frac{1}{2}}$ Section 15-85-14W6.
- 2. The daily oil allowable for the area is 9.4 3 /d.
- 3. Gas production from the area will be limited to 30 $10^3 \text{m}^3/\text{d}$.
- 4. Gas production will be conserved.
