APPLICATION FOR CONCURRENT PRODUCTION
AND GOOD ENGINEERING PRACTICE
Unocal Suncor Beatton a-23-K/94-H-2
Beatton River Halfway "F" Pool

This refers to your application of June 19, 1990, requesting approval for concurrent production under good engineering practice for the subject pool.

The Division's geological and engineering interpretation is very similar to the one presented by your company. The pool has been delineated with the drilling of the a-23-K/94-H-2 well and extensive seismic work and it is agreed that the proposed production strategy will allow economic operation of the well.

Notice of your application was published on September 13 and 20, 1990, in the British Columbia Gazette. As no written objections were received, Unocal Canada Management Limited, as operator, is hereby granted approval under section 113 of the Petroleum and Natural Gas Act to produce oil and gas concurrently under good engineering practice from the Beatton River Halfway "F" pool, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The area of approval is units 12, 13, 22 and 23 Block K/94-H-2.
- 2. The daily oil allowable for the well is 18.3 m^3 .
- 3. Gas production from the well will be limited to 28 103m3/d.
- 4. All gas production will be conserved.

- 5. The effective date of this approval will be the first date gas is conserved. The Branch must be notified of this date.
- 6. The approval is subject to periodic review and may be modified at a later date by the Director, Engineering and Operations Branch, if deemed appropriate.
