THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS ACT MINISTRY OF EMPLOYMENT AND INVESTMENT ENERGY AND MINERALS DIVISION

IN THE MATTER of a Concurrent Production scheme of Pursuit Resources Inc. (Pursuit) for producing the Inga Coplin "C" Pool with a project oil and gas allowable.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Division Head, pursuant to section 113 of the *Petroleum and Natural Gas Act*, hereby approves the Concurrent Production scheme of Pursuit for concurrent oil and gas production with project allowables, as such scheme is described in

an Application from Pursuit to the Division dated November 28, 1995, and related submission.

This scheme is approved, subject to the conditions herein contained and, in particular:

- 1. The area of the scheme shall consist of Sections 16 and 21-87-23 W6M.
- 2. The project oil allowable is 10 m³/d.
- 3. Gas production from the project will be limited to 28 10³m³/d.
- 4. All associated gas production will be conserved.
- 5. This approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate.
