
IN THE MATTER of a Concurrent Production scheme of Pursuit Resources Inc.
(Pursuit) for producing the Inga Coplin "C" Pool with a project oil and gas allowable.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Division Head, pursuant to section 113 of the *Petroleum and Natural Gas Act*, hereby approves the Concurrent Production scheme of Pursuit for concurrent oil and gas production with project allowables, as such scheme is described in

*an Application from Pursuit to the Division dated November 28, 1995,
and related submission.*

This scheme is approved, subject to the conditions herein contained and, in particular:

1. The area of the scheme shall consist of Sections 16 and 21-87-23 W6M.
2. The project oil allowable is 10 m³/d.
3. Gas production from the project will be limited to 28 10³m³/d.
4. All associated gas production will be conserved.
5. This approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate.
