*(ESSE) GEP PROJECT (2)*

Enclosed please find our approvals for a Daily Oil Allowable of 38.5 m<sup>3</sup> for the GEP area and 9.8 m<sup>3</sup> for the well 5-14-85-14. The allowable for the 5-14-85-14 well is included in the 38.5 m<sup>3</sup>/d allowable for the GEP area.

Since the Halfway oil well 5-14-85-14 is directly off-set by the Halfway oil well 11-14-85-14, lying outside the GEP area, the 5-14 well has been given an individual well allowable. The only way this restriction may be removed is for the offsetting operator to waive the application of this restriction in writing.

The GEP allowable may be revised dependent on the results of further drilling.
