**RESCINDING OF GOOD ENGINEERING PRACTICE STATUS  
SUKUNKA - BALDONNEL "E" POOL  
BP AEG W SUKUNKA a-55-J/93-P-4 (W.A. #4431)**

We are in receipt of your letter dated March 15, 1990, requesting waiver of gas allowable and subsequent rescinding of Good Engineering Practice (GEP) status on the subject well.

The Ministry concurs that the well is eligible for removal of allowable restrictions as outlined in our Information Letter E89-09 (dated November 27, 1989). Although the well is off-target, the penalty had been previously waived. As a result, our approval for GEP status dated June 17, 1988, is hereby rescinded effective March 15, 1990, and the captioned well is now allowed to produce without restriction from the Baldonnel "E" pool.
