Notice of your application dated 1987 09 03 to produce gas wells under Good Engineering Practice from the Doe Creek and Nikanassin formations in the Cutbank field was published on September 17 and 24, 1987 in the British Columbia Gazette.

As no written objections were received by October 8, 1987 the application is approved under Division 77 of the Drilling and Production Regulations subject to the following conditions:

1. The area of Good Engineering Practice is as follows:

93-P-8: Block A, Units 11-100.  
Block B, Units 11, 21, 31, 41, 51, 61,  
71, 81, 91.  
Block G, Units 1, 11, 21, 31, 41.  
Block H, Units 1-50.

2. The producing formations in the GEP area are Doe Creek and Nikanassin.

3. The daily gas allowable restrictions for individual wells are removed.

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4. This approval is subject to periodic review and may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate due to a change in circumstances by the Director, Engineering and Operations Branch.
