We wish to advise that effective November 1, 1995, the concurrent production scheme approval in the subject pool has been rescinded and full blowdown of the gas cap has been approved.

Accordingly, please note that the GEP approval granted on November 30, 1984, for the well CNRL Osprey a-45-J/94-A-15 (WA 3729) is hereby rescinded.

The gas well a-45-J/94-A-15 can now be produced from the Halfway "A" pool with no allowable restrictions.
