PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS ACT DRILLING AND PRODUCTION REGULATION THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA MINISTRY OF ENERGY, MINES AND PETROLEUM RESOURCES ENERGY RESOURCES DIVISION

IN THE MATTER of a Good Engineering Practice (GEP) scheme of Canadian Natural Resources Limited (CNRL) for producing the Weasel Halfway Pool gascap with a project gas allowable.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Division Head, pursuant to Part 8, Division 6, section 104 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, hereby approves the GEP scheme of CNRL for gas production with a project gas allowable, as such scheme is described in

an Application from CNRL to the Division dated March 2, 1995, and related submissions.

This scheme is approved, subject to the conditions herein contained and, in particular:

- 1. The area of the project shall consist of units 96, 97 of Block B and units 6,7 of Block G/94-H-2.
- 2. The project gas allowable is 28.0 E³ m³/d.
- 3. The effective date shall be the date that a pooling agreement for the gas spacing area is registered with the ministry. (September 14,1995)

4. The approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate.
