GEP APPLICATION FOR ESSO NOEL a-29-D/93-P-8
CADOTTE "A" POOL

This acknowledges receipt of your letter dated February 27, 1989, advising that Esso Resources Canada Limited (Esso) has no objection to the Division's proposal of expanding the Canadian Hunter Exploration Ltd. operated GEP area in the Noel field.


In order to maintain uniformity of operation of the pool, the Division has concluded that gas wells completed in the Noel field should be produced in a GEP mode. Therefore, we wish to advise that your application is hereby approved under Division 77 of the B.C. Drilling and Production Regulations, subject to the following conditions:

1. The area of Good Engineering Practice is as follows:
93-P-8: Block D, units 18, 19, 28 and 29.
2. The daily gas allowable restrictions for the well are removed.
3. An annual progress report for the GEP should be submitted. The progress report should contain the following:
 - list of monthly and daily gas condensate and water production;
 - summary of work performed on the well;
 - annual subsurface pressure on the well.

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4. This approval may be modified at a later date by the Director, Engineering and Operations, if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
