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

NOW, THEREFORE, the Division Head, pursuant to Part 8, Division 6, section 104 of the Drilling and Production Regulation, hereby approves a revision to the GEP scheme allowable of Mobil, as such scheme is described in

*an Application from Mobil to the Division dated July 6, 1994 and related submission.*

This scheme is approved, subject to the conditions herein contained and in particular:

1. The area of the scheme shall consist of units 74-77, 84-87, 96 and 97 of Block J/94-I-12 and units 6 and 7 of Block B/94-I-13.
2. The project gas allowable is 535 E<sup>3</sup>m<sup>3</sup>/d.
3. This approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate.
