This acknowledges receipt of your application dated June 23, 1978, requesting approval of a Good Engineering Practice scheme with Waiver of Daily Gas Allowable; also Discovery Well Status with Waiver of Off-Target Penalty for the well Pacific et al Fort St John 13-5-84-18 W6 completed in the Nancy pool.

This is to advise that your application for discovery well classification for the Nancy pool is approved and, consequently, under Section 8.06 of the British Columbia Drilling and Production Regulations, the off-target factor shall be unity.

With respect to the application for Good Engineering Practice we wish to advise that the Branch has no objection in principle, however, notice of your application will be published in the British Columbia Gazette of July 20 and 27, 1978, (copy of the notice is attached for your attention). Your application will be approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1. No valid objections are received from any interested parties.
- 2. The Good Engineering Practice area would be Sections 5,6,7 and 8-84-18 W6.
- 3. The gas allowable from the Nancy pool for the Good Engineering Practice area would be 5800 MSCFD.
