IN THE MATTER of a Good Engineering Practice (GEP) scheme of Scurry-Rainbow Oil Limited (Scurry) for producing the Stoddart West Artex "A" pool oil well with a project oil and gas allowable.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Division Head, pursuant to Part 8, Division 6, section 104 of the Drilling and Production Regulation, hereby approves the GEP scheme of Scurry for oil production with project allowables, as such scheme is described in:


(a) Application from Scurry to the Division dated May 26, 1993 and related submission.

This scheme is approved, subject to the conditions herein contained and in particular:

1. The area of the scheme shall consist of NE 1/4 Section 21-85-20 W6M.
2. The project oil allowable is 10 m³/d.
3. Gas production from the project will be limited to 7.5 E³m³/d.
4. Gas production may be flared.
5. This approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate.
