Re: Application for Good Engineering Practice Sikanni Debolt 'G' Pool

This acknowledges receipt of your application dated March 4, 1988, requesting a pool allowable under Good Engineering Practice (GEP) for the Sikanni Debolt 'G' Pool.

The Division's geological interpretation is very similar to that presented by Shell. At this time the only completed gas wells within the pool are Shell et al Sikanni b-46-L/94-G-2 and SR Sikanni b-77-L/94-G-2. As the land under the requested GEP area has been pooled, the application is approved under Division 77 of the British Columbia Drilling and Production Regulations subject to the following conditions:

- The area of GEP consists of units 36, 37, 46, 47, 56-59, 66-69, 76-79 and 86-89 Block L/94-G-2.
- 2. The daily gas allowable for the area is $485 \cdot 10^3 \text{m}^3/\text{d}$.
- 3. This approval is subject to periodic review and may be modified at a later date if deemed appropriate due to a change in circumstances.

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Please note that the drilling spacing area consisting of units 38, 39, 48 and 49-L/94-G-2 was not included in the GEP area as no Debolt 'G' pool reserves are mapped under the spacing.

The previously approved daily gas allowable for the wells b-46-L and b-77-L/94-G-2 are hereby rescinded.
