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
IN THE MATTER of a Good Engineering Practice (GEP) scheme of Wainoco Oil Corporation (Wainoco) for producing the Flatrock West Cecil "B" Pool without a project oil allowable.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Division Head, pursuant to Part 8, Division 6, section 104 of the *Drilling and Production Regulation*, hereby approves the GEP scheme of Wainoco for oil production without a project allowable, as such scheme is described in:

*an Application from Wainoco to the Division dated February 22, 1995, and related submission.*

This scheme is approved, subject to the conditions herein contained and in particular:

1. The area of the scheme shall consist of E/2 section 26-85-17 W6M.
2. The oil well within the project area may be produced without individual well allowable restrictions.
3. An oil well may be drilled anywhere within the project area provided that it is not nearer than 100 m to the sides of the approved area.
4. Associated gas production will continue to be conserved.
5. This approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate.
