OBSERVATION WELLS MONTNEY FORMATION

Commission staff have reviewed the request for approval of observation well status dated September 30, 2013 for the below listed wells. The Drilling and Production Regulation Part 1 defines an observation well as "a well or a portion of a well designated as an observation well under section 2 (7)".

- 2 (7) An official may designate a well as an observation well if
 - (a) the well is being used to monitor reservoir pressures or to obtain other formation information, and
 - (b) the well is not used to produce from, or inject or dispose of fluids into, a formation being monitored.

These wells were completed in the Montney formation on the dates indicated, but were never placed on production. Lack of activity for more than 1 year has resulted in these wells being flagged by the OGC for suspension. Murphy Oil would like to use these wellbores to monitor Montney pressures in their area of the Heritage regional field.

Approval of observation status is granted for the listed wells with requirement for pressure testing of each well in 2014 and then not more than every 3 yrs subsequently until the wells are active producers. At that time, the requirements of Drilling and Production Regulation section 73 for reservoir pressure testing will apply.
