Thankyou for your letter of October 6, 1970 on the above topic. This will confirm that the wells in the Unit will continue to be treated on an individual basis for MPA purposes, until the mechanical problems with the water injection equipment have been overcome.

The water flood project MPA has not yet been finalized, and we look forward to discussing the parameters with you on October 15, 1970. In the meantime individual well MPAs are as presented below; these values differ in some instances from the data presented in your letter.
