
**RE: APPLICATION FOR SALT WATER DISPOSAL

IN THE MATTER of a scheme of Chevron Canada Resources for Salt Water Disposal (SWD) in the Slave Point Formation in the well Chevron Clarke c-89-F/94-J-10.

The Ministry of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources, pursuant to section 116 of the Petroleum and Natural Gas Act, hereby orders as follows:

1. The SWD scheme of Chevron Canada Resources (Operator) for disposal of produced water into the Slave Point Formation at well c-89-F/94-J-10 as such scheme is described in the application from the Operator to the Ministry dated December 5, 1991, is hereby approved, subject to the terms and conditions herein contained.
2. Water disposal interval must be below 6940 ft KB.
3. The approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
