IN THE MATTER of a scheme of Chevron Canada Resources for Salt Water Disposal (SWD) in the Slave Point Formation in the well Chevron Clarke c-89-F/94-J-10.

The Ministry of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources, pursuant to section 116 of the Petroleum and Natural Gas Act, hereby orders as follows:

- 1. The SWD scheme of Chevron Canada Resources (Operator) for disposal of produced water into the Slave Point Formation at well c-89-F/94-J-10 as such scheme is described in the application from the Operator to the Ministry dated December 5, 1991, is hereby approved, subject to the terms and conditions herein contained.
- 2. Water disposal interval must be below 6940 ft KB.
- 3. The approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
