Re: Application for Water Disposal into Pacific Cabin b-42-B/94-P-5

This will confirm telephone conversation Messrs. Goemans/Barber of July 15th, 1974 during which it was stated that the Branch have now been advised by Texaco Exploration Canada Ltd. that they have withdrawn their objection to Pacific's application of April 29th, 1974 to convert the above well to water disposal service on condition that:

- 1. The well be recompleted such that water is injected into the formation below the gas-water contact
- and 2. Injection be limited to a maximum of 1500 B.W.P.D.

Further they have no objection to temporary injection provided the well is recompleted by December 31, 1974.

Pacific Petroleums stated they intend to cement a liner, perforate and inject below the gas-water contact.

The Branch therefore approves the above application to convert the well to water disposal service in the Slave Point Formation for the period up to and including December 31, 1974 subject to the following:

- 1. Water produced from the Slave Point Formation in the Cabin Field only may be injected
- and 2. Daily rate of water injection may not exceed 1500 B.W.P.D.

"Application to Alter a Well" forms should be submitted to the District Engineer at the Branch Field Office for his approval.
