## THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS ACT MINISTRY OF ENERGY, MINES AND PETROLEUM RESOURCES ENERGY RESOURCES DIVISION

IN THE MATTER of a scheme of Pennzoil Petroleums Ltd. for Salt Water Disposal (SWD) in the Pine Point Formation in the well Penzl Mobil Bulldog a-85-H/94-J-8.

The Ministry of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources, pursuant to section 116 of the <u>Petroleum and Natural Gas Act</u>, hereby orders as follows:

- 1. The SWD scheme of Pennzoil Petroleums Ltd. (Operator) for disposal of produced water into the Pine Point Formation at well a-85-H/94-J-8 as such scheme is described in the application from the Operator to the Ministry dated August 24, 1992, is hereby approved, subject to the terms and conditions herein contained.
- 2. Water disposal interval must be in the Pine Point Formation (2198-2202 and 2205-2207 mKB).
- 3. A record of volumes disposed of through this well should be included on a Monthly Injection/Disposal Statement. The statement should be submitted to the Victoria office not later than the 25th day of the month following the reported month.
- 4. The approval may be modified or rescinded at a later date if deemed appropriate through a change in circumstances.
