Your written application of November 5, 1975 has been reviewed and, since you have obtained the agreement of Great Basins Petroleum Ltd. to the disposal of this water into their well subject to appropriate treatment and filtering, the Branch has no objection to your proposal (verbal agreement given November 3, 1975 via field office).
