Re: Beatton River West Unit No. 1

We have reviewed the performance data for the subject Unit included with your letter of October 1, 1973. It is apparent that the GOR is responding to water injection. In addition, our calculations indicate that injection of 4800 BWPD (average rate in August) will balance reservoir withdrawals at the waterflood MPR of 1236 BOPD when the separator GOR is 1072 SCF/STB.

Consequently, the MPR for Beatton River West Unit No. 1 is increased to the waterflood MPR of 1236 BOPD, effective October 1, 1973.
