Block F – units 36-39, 46-49, 56-60, 66-70, 76-80, 86-90, 94, 95  
Block K – units 4, 5, 14-17, 24-27, 36, 37, 46, and 47.

If no valid objection in writing is received by the undersigned by October 28, 2008 the application may be approved subject to such conditions as may be prescribed.
