

Application for Good Engineering Practice

TAKE NOTICE that Ramshorn Canada Investments Limited, 2800, 500 – 4th Avenue S.W., Calgary, Alberta, T2P 2V6, has applied for approval to produce Horn River Formation gas from the Tattoo Field area under Good Engineering Practice (GEP).

The area requested in the GEP application is as follows:

NTS 94-O-15	Block C - units 1, 11-13, 21-23, 31-33 and 41-43.
1113 94-0-13	Block C - utility 1, 11-13, 21-23, 31-33 and 41-43.

The applicant has requested an increased gas target area, to within 100 meters of the boundaries of the area of application.

If no valid objection in writing is received by the undersigned by March 24, 2010 the application may be approved subject to such conditions as may be prescribed.
